### Noah Pasackow

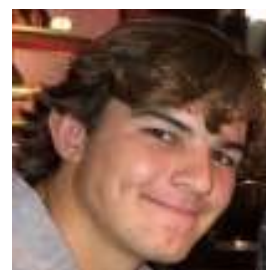

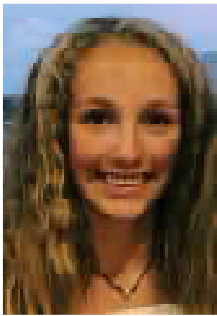


### Caroline "Cricket" Tompkins
